Dear Parents,

- **Dress for PE:** It is important that your child is correctly dressed for PE. Students must wear athletic (tennis) shoes and shorts or pants. (If girls wear dresses, they must have shorts underneath.) We have P. E. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.

- **Vocabulary Words:** Please go over these vocabulary words. We go over them in class, but often that is not enough. Your child has worked with them everyday. By Friday, your child should be very familiar with them.

If your child is missing more than 1 or 2 words on a page (this does not include names), then the book is too difficult. - In Language, we have been working on writing sentences. We have studied nouns and verbs in sentences. Now we are trying to make the

sentences longer by adding adjectives to them.

- In math, we are studying how to add 2 and 3-digit numbers without regrouping.
