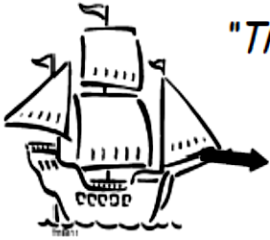
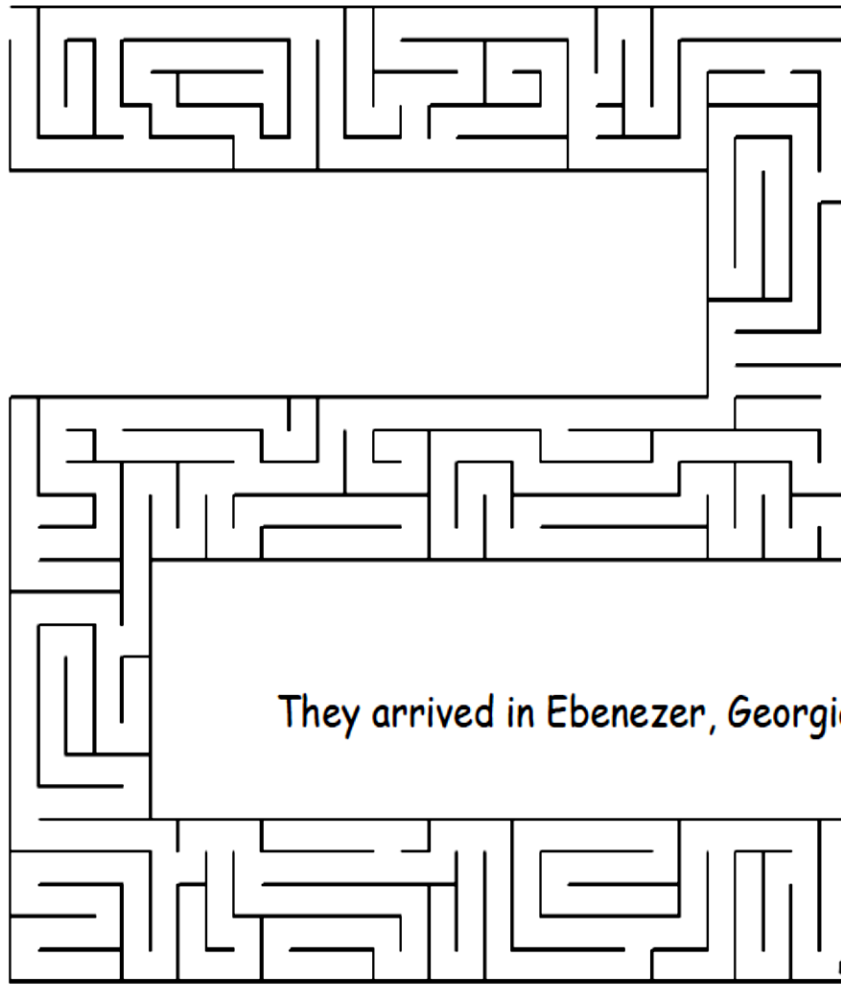


"It Was Quite A Journey"

In 1733, a group of about 60 Salzburgers began their journey in Augsburg, Germany. From Augsburg to Dover, England, where they boarded the *Purysburg* (ship) and set sail for Georgia.



"They left Salzburg in 1731."

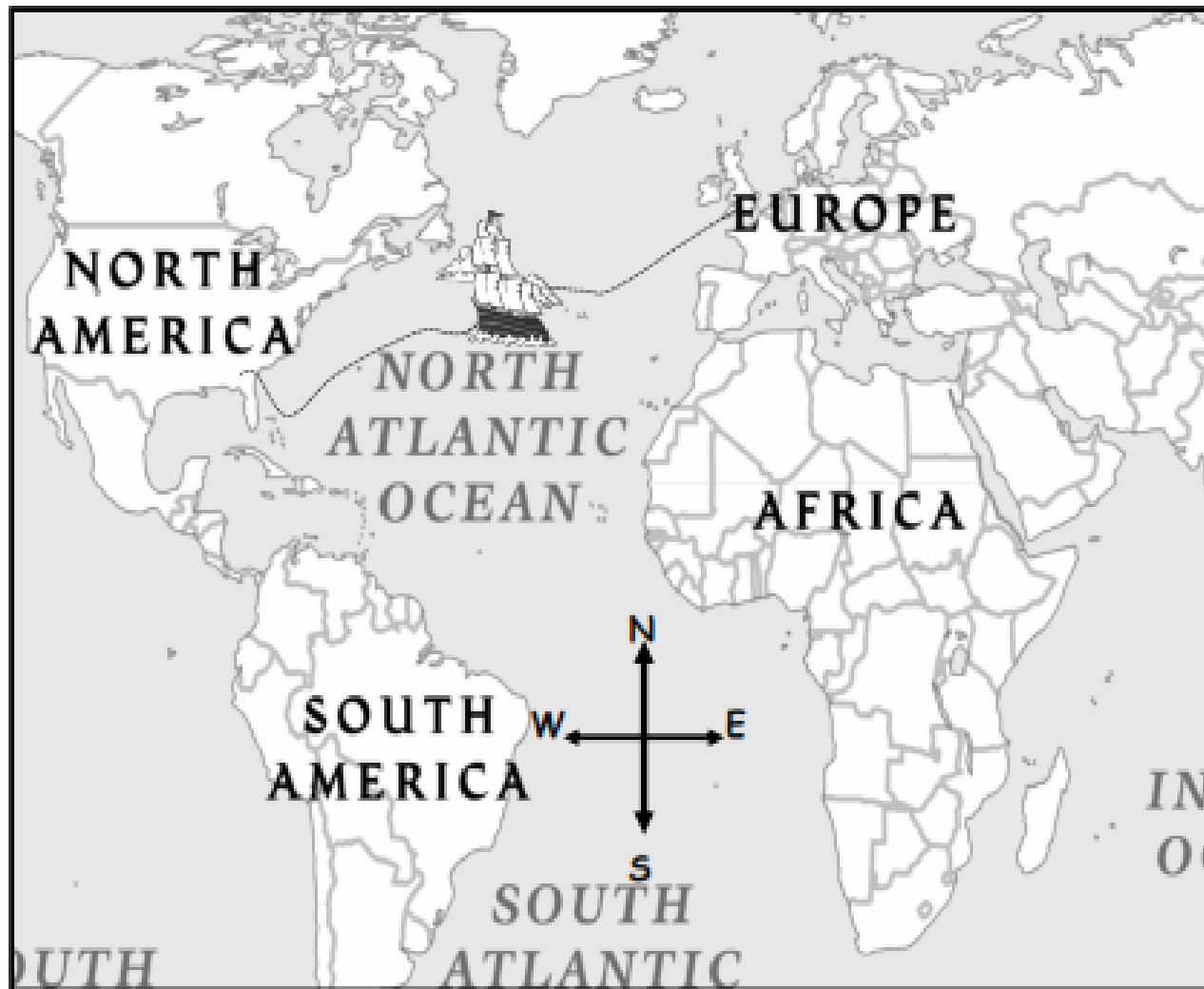


Purysburg made it to Savannah, Georgia on March 12, 1734, with 37 Salzburgers still alive; they then traveled several miles to the settlement. They called their new home Ebenezer, "stone of protection."

Salzburg was across the Atlantic Ocean in Europe near Austria. The Salzburger made a very long journey to America. They left England in 1734 and set sail for Georgia. They arrived in Savannah, March 12, 1734. Then traveled several more miles to the settlement they named Ebenezer.
