





Salzburgers & Mulberry Trees

The Salzburgers promised to plant mulberry trees so that silk could be produced.

How do you get silk from a tree?

1. You wait for a little *moth* to come along and lay *eggs* on the tree's leaves.
2. When the *eggs hatch* a little *caterpillar* comes out and begins to eat the mulberry leaves.
3. After they get fat, the *caterpillars spin* a *cocoon* of silk threads around themselves.
4. The women would boil these cocoons and carefully *unwind* the long *silk thread*. (Don't ask about the poor silkworms!!)
5. The thread was used for *fabric* (cloth).
6. The fabric was made into *clothes* of rich people.
